THINGS TO NOTE

Tax Information

As indicated last year, this year the 15% discount offered to ratepayers will be graduated, meaning that the discount from January to March will be 15%; April to June will be 10%; and July to August will be 5%. Prepayments of taxes prior to the May levy will be calculated based on the prior year's taxes. Remember, we encourage prepayments and postdated cheques.

Fireworks

Just a reminder that the Village does have a Fireworks bylaw and you need a permit to set off fireworks anytime of the year. If anyone would like a copy of our bylaw, please come into the office.

Golf Carts

All Golf Carts will require a licence to operate within Village Limits (excluding the golf course). This licence can be picked up at the Village office for a cost of \$25.00. Those without a license will be fined. Those without a valid drivers license are not permitted to operate a golf cart, this include under-age drivers!! This license will register your golf cart for life and information about the cart owner will be taken. If infractions are noted by security the licence will be recorded and owners will be issued a ticket.

Garbage & Recycling

For those who haven't noticed, the Village has placed a recycle bin west of the Community Hall. This office has had very positive feedback about this bin! Our future garbage concerns relate to this recycle bin, as it will hopefully reduce excess household garbage being thrown out.

As a favour to everyone, please flatten all cardboard before placing in the recycle bin. Also, please let the Village office know when the recycle bin is full.

We are no longer able to haul any garbage to the Cochin Landfill. Therefore we have installed a transfer site that we are hauling our household garbage to. The gates will be locked and only the village vehicles will be allowed into the compound.

This year it was decided to have two clean-up dates. The weeks after the May long weekend and September long weekend will be designated as cleanup weeks and we will be collecting articles from the front of your property. A fee may be charged depending on size and weight of items. **Appliances will be picked up however there will be a \$50 charges to dispose anything which has freon.**

Annual Meeting and Open House

Council will be holding an annual meeting and open house to be held on Sunday July 6, 2014 at 2:00 pm. The meeting will be held at the town hall and following we will have the doors open to the firehall and water treatment plant for all to inspect.

Boaters, please respect the purpose of buoys and obey boating speed limits.

Boat storage fees should be paid to the Village office by May 31, 2013.

Streetlight out? Report it to SaskPower at 310-2220 – only you know the exact location.

Building / Plumbing Permits: are required prior to construction – permits are available at the Village office.

Business Licenses: if you are contracting anyone to do work for you, make sure they have acquired a Business License from the Village office.

Pet stations are located at the west-end of Poplar Crescent, by the public washrooms on the main beach and at the far west end of the Aqualane.
