

Emergency Measures Organization
Resort Village of Aquadeo

1. Individual Plan

- It is important that individual households plan and practice an emergency evacuation procedure for their own home/cottage.
- Your individual evacuation plan should include:
 - i. Primary and alternate escape routes.
 - ii. A central location where everyone meets after their evacuation
 - iii. A procedure for notifying appropriate authorities of your emergency (ie. Phone 911)
 - iv. An “all clear” re-entry signal.

2. Community Plans

- When a local emergency necessitates a community evacuation order an Evacuation Headquarters will be established at the Village Community Hall in the downstairs west door.
- You will be advised of an evacuation order by any or all of the notices following:
 - i. Continuous sounding of the village emergency siren.
 - ii. Door-to-door notification by local volunteers.
- When you are notified to evacuate, you should:
 - i. Exit your premise by the nearest exit. Please familiarize yourself with exit locations.
- If there is situation where an emergency is created without time for notification (ie. Windstorms/Plow wind), you should access the situation and leave your home/cabin/trailer if safe to do so and proceed to the Village Community Hall.
- Following the evacuation everyone should promptly report to Evacuation Headquarters where your name and location will be recorded so that official and family can be advised of you safety.
- When it is safe to return to you home/cabin/trailer you will be advised by the EMO co-ordinators.
